STAGE 3 BAYWIDE CHAMPIONSHIP ROUND (7 WEEKS)

- Premier 8 teams made up of top 4 placed teams from each section 1 pool
- Division 1 8 teams made up of bottom 2 placed teams from each section 1 pool and top 2 placed teams from each section 2 pool
- Division 2 8 teams made up of bottom 4 placed teams from each section 2 pool
- Division 3 Selected from local competitions (as per current structure)

STAGE 4 BARTERCARD BAYWIDE SEMI-FINALS AND FINALS DAY (2 WEEKS)

As per the current competition structure

ELIGIBILITY FOR STAGE 2

All 12 teams must have an age grade team available for the Bay wide Club Competition draw i.e. Colts or 19.

BAY OF PLENTY CLUB RUGBY FORMAT

In the event of an age grade team not available at time of;

- a) Issue of official draw will result in relegation to section 2 of the senior team. Replaced from team 13 from section 2.
- b) First playing day default will result in relegation to section 2 of the senior team. Replaced from team 13 from section 2.
- c) Playing the first game and then default second playing game will result in relegation of the senior team to section 2. Replaced from team 13 from section 2.

Note: Relegated senior team and promoted team would start their new competition with no points at game three.

Section 2 teams 13 and 14 (after pool play) to be given the opportunity for promotion into section 1. These teams are Ngongotaha (13) Rangiuru (14) If either or both teams 13 and 14 decline to be promoted, then senior team for demotion to continue in section 1 BUT is no longer eligible to advance to Premier round starting 14/6/08

- d) Second default in 1st round of age grade team (ie after game 3) the senior team will continue in section 1 BUT will no longer eligible to advance to Premier round starting 14/6/08

PROMOTION / RELEGATION

The promotion/relegation format for the bottom finishing teams of Division 2 is as follows:

The bottom placed team in Division 2 (24th overall) will automatically be replaced by the winner of the Division 3 competition.

The 2nd to bottom team of Division 2 (23rd overall) will be required to play off the runner up in the Division 3 competition for the right to play in Section 2 the following year.

DIVISION 3

A competition of eight (8) teams will be set up each year consisting of teams that are available to advance the following year into Baywide. Each region will provide available Senior A teams from their respective local competitions to play in this competition. The top 2 qualifying teams from each region shall have priority; the remaining spots will be decided by ballot if required. This competition will be a round robin, starting at the same time as the other Baywide Divisional competitions, with semi-finals and finals. This competition will provide the teams for promotion and the promotion playoff.

LOCAL COMPETITIONS

Local competitions will be run and organised by the respective regions.

COLTS

A Baywide Colts Competition will be drawn up when the number of teams is known. The age for the Colts is 21 years and under on 1 January 2009

UNDER 19

A Baywide under 19 Competition will be

drawn up when the number of teams is known. The age for the Under 19 Competition is 18 years and under on 1 January 2009.

REGRADING

Any player who during the season is named on the official team sheet and takes the field in four (4) or more higher graded games will need regrading before they can take the field at a lower level again. The BOPRU Baywide Committee will be responsible for all regrading.

BAYWIDE CLUB COMPETITION RULES FOR 2009

1. All teams are to be available at least 20 minutes before a game commencing for team inspection by the referee. A regional official or club official (designated host/home club) must make him/ herself known to the referee and visiting team 20 minutes before official game start time. Failure by host club to do so may result in a fine not exceeding \$200.00.
2. The designated host/home team shall provide an official triplicate team sheet book. The host/home team is required to fill out their portion of the team sheet and hand the book onto the opposition who fill out their portion. The completed form, still attached to the book is then handed onto the referee, preferably 10 to 15 minutes before game start. No team sheet, no game.

3. At the conclusion of the game, managers of both teams are to confer with the referee and confirm the score and all relevant details and sign the team sheet before having the referee sign off the team sheet. The winning team manager is then responsible for faxing ,emailing or posting the completed team sheet to the body controlling that particular competition. (Baywide & Senior Competitions)

Additional players (refer rule 7) must be added to the team sheet prior to the referee signing off.

Winning team's management/ official must then either fax, email or deliver the completed team sheet and match evaluation form to the Bay of Plenty Rugby Union office to arrive no later than 10:00am the following Monday morning and/ or if it is a mid week game, the signed team sheet and evaluation forms must be in at the office by 10:00 am the following morning. (Baywide & Senior Competitions)

In the event of a draw, it is the designated host/home team's responsibility to complete this process.

Points for Bay of Plenty Rugby Union competitions will be collated only from the information provided in the **results section** of the **official team sheet**

EVALUATION FORMS are to be completed by both teams and actioned as above.

BAY OF PLENTY CLUB RUGBY RULES

Failure to provide **team sheet and match evaluation form** on time may mean no points and/or a fine not exceeding \$300.00.

4. All teams and referees are required to be on the grounds ready to commence at the appointed time.

4a Senior Baywide & local Senior Competitions to be refereed under **International Rules** as all players are registered as and deemed to be Senior players.

4b If the appointed referee does not turn up to referee, for whatever reason, the two teams need to agree upon a replacement referee. If they cannot agree, the home team appoints a referee. (Law 6.A.1)

If the replacement referee is a Registered Rugby Referee, or has completed Rugby Smart and is a Registered Associate Referee, there may be a contest in the scrums.

If the replacement referee has not done Rugby Smart, and is neither a Registered Referee or a Registered Associate Referee, Golden Oldie scrums must be applied i.e. there is to be no contest in the scrums.

5. Provided the ground is clear, the referee is to commence time running at the appointed time.

6. From the appointed time, provided rule 5 applies, teams have:

Five minutes for local teams to be on the field before a **no match** is declared by the referee on that team.

Fifteen minutes for a visiting team to be on the field before a no match is declared by the referee.

Clubs have the right to protest. Refer **law 20** for procedure.

The BOPRU Baywide Committee will deal with "no match" replays.

6a For 'no match' replays and postponed fixtures, the host Club has until 10am Wednesday following to suggest in writing alternative fixture details to BOPRU Office. Final decisions will be made by the BOPRU Baywide Committee

6b The official match ball for all BOP Rugby Competitions shall be used for all fixtures. Failure to adhere to rule 6b could result in disciplinary action

7. Teams must have a **minimum of 12 players** before taking the field (5 forwards with a front row, plus one replacement front row player).

In line with NZRU regulations, ALL players must wear an approved mouth guard throughout the game.

Players unable to produce a mouth guard at the time of inspection WILL NOT be permitted to take the field.

Players observed not wearing a mouth

guard during the game will be sent from the field by the referee to obtain another mouth guard (as in the blood bin regulations).

Law 26 NZRU (Misconduct) may be invoked by the referee for persistent offending regarding no mouth guard.

A maximum of 22 players shall be presented ready for play/replacement or substitution at the commencement of the match.

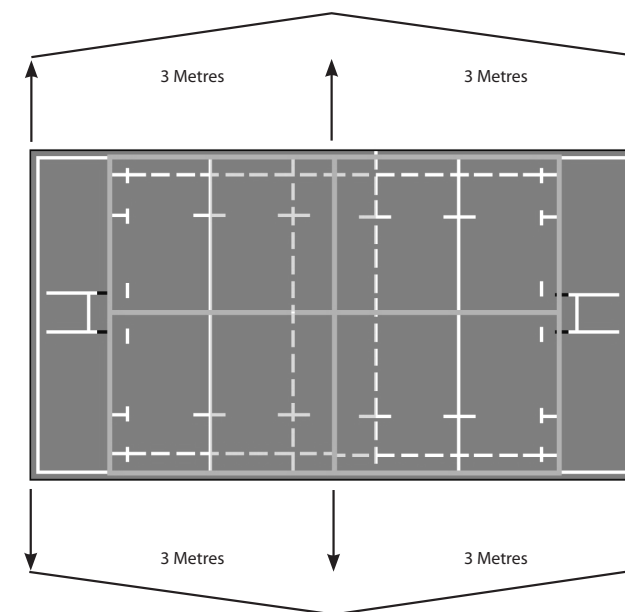
These maximum 22 players shall be the players entered in the original team sheet available prior to game time.

The NZRU rules regarding nomination

of players for replacement/substitution, injured players and the replacement and substituted players (i.e. Rule no's 5 to 13) will be strictly adhered to by referees and appointed officials

7a Colts and 18 years and Under Competition the Additional Domestic Safety Rules apply.

8. Except for the official on field teams, three official persons per team (these persons to include medical staff and water people), all spectators, team officials and reserves are to remain behind the crowd control barriers before and during the game. These three persons per team need to be clearly identified (ie bibs)



BAY OF PLENTY CLUB RUGBY RULES

It is the responsibility of Sub Unions to ensure that all grounds under their jurisdiction meet the required standards as prescribed in the NZRU handbook, prior to the commencement of the season.

Failure of clubs to fulfill requirements of above shall result in the home team venue being reviewed. Home games may be reallocated to a neutral venue at the discretion of the BOPRU Baywide Committee.

9. Referees are to note on their match reports any:

Stoppages for crowd behaviour

If a Regional or Club delegate does not make him or herself known before the start of the game (refer rule 1).

10. All ordering off and sin bins are to be reported by the referee on the official form provided and informed to the Bay Office by the following deadlines:

Saturday Games: 9.00 am the following Monday morning

Sunday Games: 9.00 am the following Monday morning

Mid-week Games: 9.00 am the following day

Failure by referee to fulfill his/her obligation will result in disciplinary action by the Bay of Plenty Rugby Union.

11. Penalties – NZRU Disciplinary Penalties

(Section 3) will apply.

All penalties imposed by Judiciary will comply with the New Zealand Rugby Union Disciplinary Penalties Section 3.

These penalties include up to 10 weeks stand down period for serious offending.

Any player who is sin binned three times during the season is to appear before the judicial committee before playing again.

All forms must be filled out as per instructions for ordering off and sin bins.

A nil tolerance policy is in place for referee abuse from players, officials and club supporters.

12. In the event of team colour clashes, the home team shall make the jersey (colour) changes to clearly distinguish players/teams.

13. Clubs must register their players with the BOPRU at least 48 hours prior to playing any Competition game

Overseas players returning must be cleared by the Club they last played for, as well as the Union or Country they last played in. International clearance forms are available at the BOPRU Office.

Players can not register with a BOPRU Club until an approved International

Clearance and/or transfer has been received by the BOPRU.

There is no transfer required for players moving between Clubs and Unions in New Zealand outside of the Competition window. During the Competition window player transfers will only be considered on application to the BOPRU Baywide Committee.

14. All Senior teams/players must be registered with their Club by Thursday 2nd April. Playing an unregistered player may result in a club being fined up to \$1,000.00 and/or loss of points.

Clubs are to ensure that all Registration forms are returned to the Union's office by Thursday 2nd April. Failure to register teams by due date may mean default from Bay of Plenty Rugby Union competitions and a fine not exceeding \$500.00.

15. The referee has the right to send off any players he suspects is under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol.

16. No team will be allowed to play in any competition within the Bay of Plenty if the head coach and his assistant have not attended a current compulsory Rugby Smart Seminar. (includes acting coach of the day and assistants)

17. Any games called off by the referee or postponed, the BOPRU Baywide Committee will deal with the outcome, i.e. replay, points allocation. Refer to rule 6a.

18. Any player playing under a false name may be banned for the remainder of the season. Any club playing a player under a false name will be dealt with by the BOPRU Disciplinary Committee.

19. BOPRU Judicial, Competitions and Disciplinary Committees decisions on fines and infringements are binding

- 19a The above Committees may impose further Disciplinary actions besides fines or stand downs on Clubs/ Persons appearing. All outcomes subject to Appeal.

20. The protest should be made within 48 hours of the completion of the match, in writing to the Bay of Plenty Rugby Union Chief Executive Officer, and be accompanied by a cheque of \$200.00. This fee will be refunded unless the protest is deemed frivolous.

Where a cause for protest is known before a match the opposing team should be notified and if the complaint is remedied then no further action will be required by the protesting team. **The incident must be noted on their match day evaluation form.**

If the team protested against is unable or unwilling to remedy matters then the game should be played **under protest** (and a written protest must be given to the referee).

Where the ground for protest is discovered during or after the game, a protest can follow after the match.

BAY OF PLENTY CLUB RUGBY RULES

20a The protest hearing outcome may be subject to right of appeal by the affected Club. The appeal should be made within 24 hours of receipt of protest result. Appeal must be in writing to the BOPRU accompanied by a cheque of up to \$1000.00. Any further right of appeal must be directed to the NZRFU.

21. Game start times – All Regions:

First Game: 1:00pm
Second Game: 2:45pm

Alternative times may be used at the discretion of Regions, but both the visiting team and the referee must be notified by noon, 4 days prior to the game.

Alternative times applied for by one club must be mutually agreed upon by the opposing club and the request must be on the Official Change of Time or Venue form, signed by both parties and received by the Bay of Plenty Rugby Union office by noon, 4 days prior to the game.

Notification of the referee is the home team's responsibility.

22. Defaults

If a senior team defaults the fine may be a maximum of \$1,000.00 regardless and ineligible to play until the fine is paid to Bay of Plenty Rugby Union. Any further penalty will be at the discretion of the BOPRU Baywide Committee. Defaults are to be notified to the Bay of

Plenty Rugby Union office no later than noon on the day preceding a match.

No notification will result in:

- \$500.00 fine (as well as original default fine of a maximum of \$1,000.00)
- Payment of the oppositions travel costs, up to a maximum of \$500.00. Such costs to be supported by the actual travel invoice.
- Payment of the referee's travel costs – both ways.

The defaulting team has the responsibility of notifying the referee's appointment officer,

Any defaults considered unwarranted by the BOPRU Baywide Committee from grades other than Senior A, the same fine of \$1,000.00 and subsequent conditions/fines will apply.

23. Points:

Win: 4 Points
Draw: 2 Points
One bonus point for 4 tries.
One bonus point for a loss of 7 points or less. **All bonus points to be earned on the field of play.**

Points gained to date shall determine a team's position in the Points Table.

If level on the table:

Who beat who during the previous round or rounds played in that competition where points are accumulating.

If still level:
A count back will apply of points for and against **between the level teams.**

If still level:
All points for and against in that round(s).

If still level:
Toss a coin under the control of the BOPRU Baywide Committee
Note: Points table will be published on the BOPRU website the following Thursday at the latest, clubs will have 14 days from the website published date to challenge points.

Final decision will be made by the BOPRU Baywide Committee.

24a The option of playing night games at Baywide level is available to clubs

providing that the lights meet the required lighting levels for Clubs (160 lux) and that all the required change of time, change of venue forms are filled out and actioned. If a night game is stopped due to player safety, weather, or light failure, that game must be 75% completed before a result can be achieved.

25. For all Bay of Plenty Rugby Union **Senior** Baywide competitions, Clubs may enter only one team.

26. The venue for the Baywide Clubs Finals will be determined by the following format:

If both Premier finalists are from the same region then the venue for all finals will be at their regions headquarters or designated ground.

If the Premier finalists are from different regions, then a points system will be used to determine the finals venue:

Finalist Premier Teams will be allocated 2 points each.

All other grades, Division 1, Division 2, Division 3, Colts, Under 19s and Senior Reserves will be allocated 1 point each.

In the event of regions being equal after the above equation, the venue will be allocated to the highest seeded Premier Finalist of the equal regions.

To host the finals, the region must have a Premier Division Finalist.

IRB EXPERIMENTAL LAW VARIATIONS (ELVS) SUMMARY

- GLOBAL TRIAL

LAW DESCRIPTION

1. To assist in decision making, Assistant Referees are able to assist the referee in any way that the referee requires.

MAUL

2. It is no longer a penalisable offence if players join the maul with heads and shoulders below the hips.
3. A maul can now be pulled down. This must be done by grasping an opponent between the shoulder and hips and bringing the maul to the ground.
Note: The NZRU has, in line with IRB regulations, determined that ELVs 2 & 3 (relating to the Maul) will not be applied in any grades of rugby, Under 19 level or below during 2009.

LINEOUT AND THROW

4. If a team passes or takes the ball back into their own 22 and the ball is subsequently kicked out on the full, the lineout is where the ball was kicked from, unless a tackle has been made or a ruck or maul has formed within the 22 metre area.
5. A quick throw may be thrown in straight or back towards the throwing team's own goal line.
6. There is no maximum number of players in the lineout – teams do not have to match numbers.
7. The receiver (halfback) must stand 2 metres back from the Lineout.
8. The player who is in opposition to the player throwing the ball, must stand in the area between the 5 metre line and touch line and must be 2 metres away from the Lineout.

9. Lineout players may pre-grip a jumper before the ball is thrown in. (Under 13 DSLV Law still applies)
10. The lifting of Lineout jumpers is permitted. (Under 13 DSLV Law still applies)

SCRUM

11. The offside line for backs (except the halfback) is now five metres behind the hindmost foot/player of each team in the scrum.
12. The halfback may follow the ball or move to the offside line at the hindmost foot. The halfback of the team who has not won the ball may move away from the scrum but must not overstep that offside line. (DSLVLaws still apply)

CORNER POSTS

13. The corner posts are no longer considered to be in touch in-goal except when the ball is grounded against the post. If the ball hits the corner post and bounces back into the playing area, play continues. A try will still be disallowed if the ball is grounded against the corner post. A try will no longer be disallowed if the ball carrier or the ball touches the corner post before grounding the ball as long as that player or the ball has not otherwise been in touch.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- The Laws of the Game, unless specifically amended by the ELVs, remain unaltered.
- The ELVs also apply to the Sevens, Under 19 Variations and NZRU DSLV's (excluding ELVs 2 & 3)

2009 NZ COMMUNITY (SCHOOL AND CLUB) RUGBY

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

LINEOUT

Question

Must the non-throwing team have an immediate opponent to the thrower i.e. have a player standing between the touch line and the 5 metre line?

Answer

Yes

Question

Must the immediate opponent of the thrower stand at a mark 2 metres away from the lineout?

Answer

No, he must stand a minimum of 2 metres away from the lineout but can stand anywhere from 2 metres to 9.9 metres away from the lineout, provided he is standing between the touch line and the 5 metre line.

Question

Must a team have a receiver (halfback) at the lineout?

Answer

No

Question

With there now being no requirement for an equal number of participants from each team, can players who have joined the

lineout now leave and retire to the 10 metre offside line, at any stage prior to the ball being thrown in?

Answer

No. Players, once having joined the lineout, must stay in the lineout. The change in numbers policy does not preclude the implementation of current Law. The only reason players of the non-throwing team were previously allowed to leave the lineout, was to conform to numbers.

Question

From a kick by the attacking team the ball bounces into touch 10 metres outside the defenders 22, the ball then continues to bounce along the touchline until it stops 2 metres inside the 22. Can a defender take a quick throw-in inside the 22 and then kick directly into touch and achieve a gain in ground?

Answer

Yes. In this situation the attacking team have put the ball inside the 22 and a gain in ground by the defenders is permitted.

SCRUM

Question

If the immediate opponent of the player throwing the ball into the scrum (halfback), first takes up a position behind the hindmost feet at the back of the scrum, can he later move forward to follow the ball around the scrum?

Answer

No. By choosing to take up a position at

the hindmost foot, this player's offside line is the hindmost foot and he cannot advance in front of it until the scrum is ended.

Question

If the immediate opponent of the player throwing the ball into the scrum (halfback), first takes up a position behind the hindmost feet at the back of the scrum, can he move anywhere along this offside line?

Answer

No. He must remain within close proximity (1 metre) of the scrum. The option to move anywhere along the hindmost foot offside line exists only if he has first taken up a position at the tunnel until the ball is thrown into the scrum.

CORNER POSTS

QUESTION

Does the ELV relating to the corner post also relate to the post at the junction of the touch-in-goal line and dead ball line.

Answer

Yes. The ELV refers to the corner posts and applies to the corner posts on the goal line and dead ball line.

1. Participate for the enjoyment of the game.
2. Learn the laws of the game and abide by them.
3. Foster open communications between captains and referee, however always respect the referee's decision, as his decision is final. Any abuse, physical or verbal, of the referee will not be tolerated by the Club or Union.
4. Support all efforts to remove physical and verbal abuse from the field of play, amongst supporters and within the clubrooms.
5. Treat all participation from opposition teams with the respect with which we would like to be treated.
6. Encourage good sportsmanship and applaud good play whether by our team or the opposition.
7. Acknowledge that all Rugby will be played under the 'spirit of the game' philosophy.
8. Acknowledge the principles of fair play by adopting a play hard, play-fair policy.

9. Drive a 'sport for all' policy catering for all junior, women's, senior, disabled and disadvantaged members of our community.
10. Be a great host to all visiting groups, referees, etc and acknowledge them in speeches and provide refreshment and food when and where appropriate.
11. Ensure that all fields are marked, goal post pads in place and the appropriate crowd control barriers are erected.
12. Ensure that teams are allocated changing rooms, which are secure and acceptable.
13. Adhere to all BOPRU competition rules for all fixtures.
